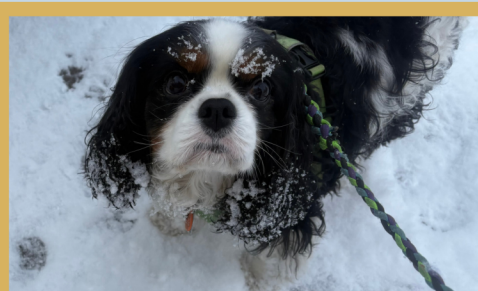

As **Pastor & Head of Staff at Arvada Presbyterian Church** from 2017–2022, she guided a merger with Trinity Presbyterian Church to become Community of Grace.

Previously, Rev. Sausville spent ten years at **Westminster Presbyterian Church in Connecticut as Associate Pastor & Acting Head of Staff**, where she engaged in interfaith & ecumenical work, partnering with the Jewish Federation of Hartford & IRIS (Integrated Refugee & Immigrant Services).

She began ministry as **Chaplain at Westminster Woods Camp & Conference Center** in California.

Rev. Sausville holds an **M.Div from Princeton Seminary** with a Women's Studies Emphasis. She graduated from **the University of Northern Colorado in Performing & Visual Arts**. Additionally, she earned a **Certificate in Community Organizing from Smith Seminary**.
